



Non-Human Primate Information Sheet

ANNUAL LICENSING is contingent upon:

- **Completion of the application form;**
- **Submission of a statement from a veterinarian licensed to practice in the State of Oklahoma that the animal does not present a public health danger;**
- **Submission of a health certificate for each animal from a veterinarian licensed to practice in the State of Oklahoma.**

The health certificate must indicate that each animal has been tested for:

Salmonella **Shigella** **Amoebic dysentery**

Herpes B (not required for New World monkeys)

Any other disease that the Shelter Supervisor may specify in writing to the City Clerk, provided, the Shelter Supervisor may specify for testing only diseases that the non-human primate, as a possible carrier thereof, might transmit to a human being.

The Shelter Supervisor may exempt a particular non-human primate from the requirement for a particular test and authorize the issuance of a license without such test if the Shelter Supervisor, in consultation with the licensed veterinarian attending the animal, determines that conducting such a test on the animal would pose a serious hazard to the animal's life or health; and if the person owning, possessing, keeping or harboring the animal files an affidavit with the Shelter Supervisor that the animal will be kept confined in the home of such person and will not be taken out in public.

- \$25.00 annual registration fee per animal
- \$100.00 annual license fee for breeders, in addition to the above certificate of health required for each animal

Registration form, health certificate(s) and registration fee (check, money order, cash or credit card) are submitted to the Office of the City Clerk, 24 E. First Street, or mail to P.O. Box 2970, Edmond 73083. When reviewed and if approved by the Shelter Supervisor, the City Clerk will then issue the non-human primate license.
